Description: Deceased gray and white neutered male cat, approximately 2-3 years old and weighing 9.4 pounds.

History: The cat was presented to the John Ancrum S.P.C.A. on August 4, 2000 by Charleston County Animal Control for necropsy. The cat had died on August 4, 2000 at Folly Road Animal Hospital during a dental procedure conducted by Tom Sheridan.

Pathological Findings:

1. rigor mortis
2. conjunctival swelling, Left eye.
3. serosanguinous discharge at Left commissure of mouth.
4. Extracted Right upper pre-molar 3.
5. Mild tartar and periodontal disease of Left pre-molar 3 and molars 1.
6. Puncture wound on mid-ventral aspect of tongue, approximately on midline.
7. Free air movement into and out of lungs with external compression. Minimal post-mortem pulmonary consolidation and no obstruction of mouth, trachea or major bronchi.
8. Hemorrhage in abdominal cavity. Approximately 3-5 ml of blood located freely in cavity.
9. Clotted blood evident on the visceral surface of liver. Multiple ruptures of left liver lobe, two were less than 0.5 cm and one was approximately 1.5 cm.
